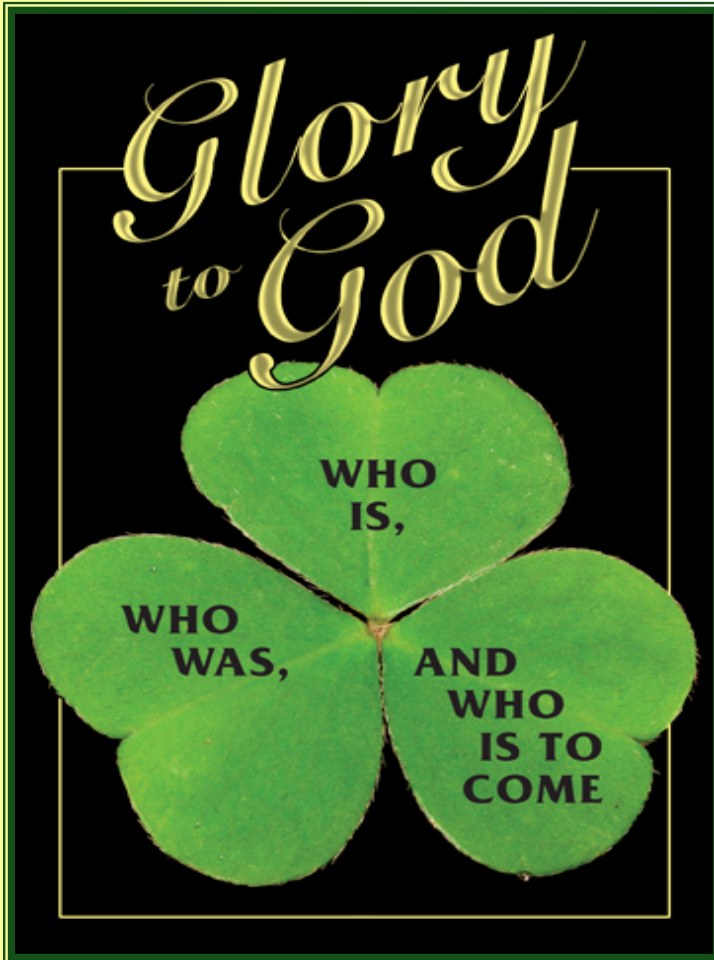

CHRIST FORETOLD

The evening will end with Mass. Each day begins with breakfast at 6:45, morning program at 7:30, worksite at 8:00. Assigned projects can be home repair, yard cleanup, daycare work or social service center. We return to school at 3:30, having time to shower, relax, or pick up a game of basketball or Frisbee. Daily Mass is at 4:30, dinner at 5:15, more free time before the evening programs which are high energy dramas with fun games and music. Friday is a "Free Day!" We (St. Patrick) will choose an area attraction as a group. Where would *YOU* like to go? The last day ends with Mass and closing summary. We will be home by noon on Saturday.
