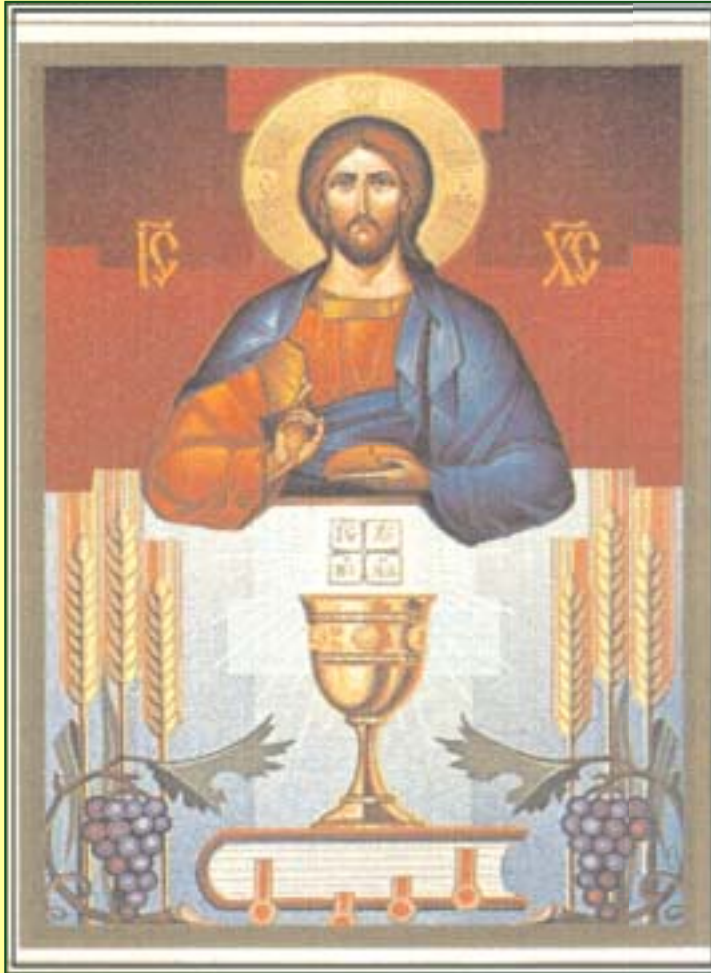

CHRIST FORETOLD

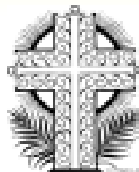

"RESTORE EDUCATION TAX CREDITS"

Hundreds of students in our Diocese are affected! Operation Restore is a campaign to restore the funding for Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) Program to \$75 million-the level at which it was funded in fiscal year 2007-08. Education tax credits are targeted for budget cuts even though basic education funding is being increased by \$354 million. We must demonstrate overwhelming parent, school, business and community support for funding restoration for the EITC program. We can't do it without your help?
